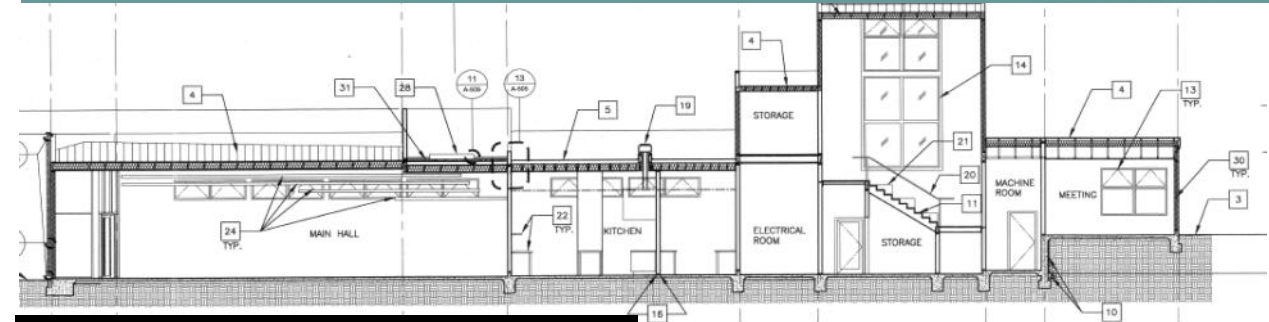


Miracles Happen!

Our new hall will have a 2,100 square foot community meeting space, a lounge, a library, an open volunteer workroom, a dedicated church group meeting space, additional meeting rooms, an upper level outdoor meeting space, a beautiful new kitchen, four restrooms (including two unisex), and an accessible elevator. The landscape plan for the campus removes mobility barriers. There will be one path for all to the meeting house — a gentle slope for foot, wheelchair, stroller and walker. The landscape plans include San Diego native trees, shrubs, citrus trees, and grasses.

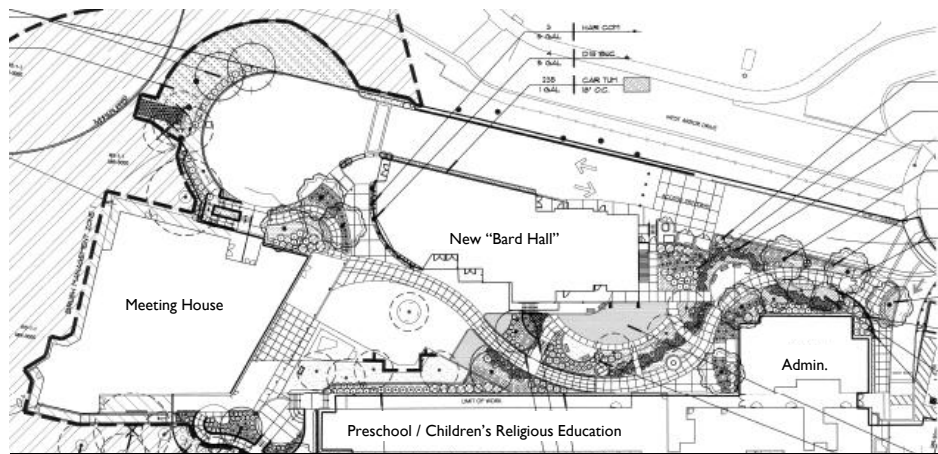


A Gift of Cash

One way to give is to write a check or bring cash for the offering on Sunday, Nov. 6. If you cannot attend services on that day, you can contribute before or after that date. *Special pledge forms* are available on our website and in our church office.

For those who would like to make a larger contribution than they can give right now, a **PLEDGE** can be made to be paid monthly, quarterly or even annually *over one to four years*—not to go beyond June 30, 2016.

A one-time payment can be made by credit card via the church website as well. Just hit the giving button on the home page when you log onto our website.

Donating a Car

Almost all cars are accepted - even if your car has engine trouble or can't pass a smog test. Your car does not need to run, or have current registration, but it must have an engine and be towable. Cars in extremely poor condition or out of our tow range may be declined, as the cost to tow them may be more than the value of the vehicle.

Just call **1-877-537-5277** or log onto **our church website**. All you need is a clear title, and we'll take care of the rest, including pickup, usually within 24 to 48 hours. There is no cost to you. You can also donate trucks, RVs, boats, and motorcycles!

Once your vehicle has been sold, you'll be sent a receipt for your tax records, and the sale proceeds will be donated to First UU Church of San Diego in your name. We can even accept cars from friends and relatives out of state!

Stocks & Securities

Stocks You Hold at a Brokerage Firm

You may wish to call your broker to ask the preferred procedure. Some companies require signature guarantees. Or, you may simply write your own letter to your broker. Contact our Director of Opera-

tions, Robie Evans, for an example letter. Be sure to send a copy of your communications to Robie, as the broker will not notify the church. Alternatively, you can call Robie at **619-298-9978, ext. 8003** to alert her that a certain stock will show up in the church's account statement soon.

Securities Held in Your Name

If you hold the stock certificate yourself, we suggest you take it in person to a Schwab branch office rather than bringing it to the Church. You can locate the



nearest office by calling Charles Schwab at **1-866-855-9102**. The Schwab staff will show you where to sign your certificate on the back. They will give you a transfer authorization form to sign and will give you a receipt. You may also do this procedure by sending your broker a signed stock certificate by insured mail with a letter of instruction.

Assigning earned dividends directly to the Church is another easy way to assure a meaningful contribution.
