- Narrative or descriptive kind of instrumental music linked to a scene, idea, poem or story.



Enjoy an afternoon of music written with included text, where the music paints a sound-picture of the words. The concert will begin on the harpsichord, with Kuhnau's "The Battle Between David and Goliath, a young J.S. Bach's "Capriccio on the Departure of a Beloved Brother", and Dussek's "The Sufferings of the Queen of France". If you are curious how the sound of a guillotine is depicted on the harpsichord, don't miss this! We will then move to the piano, and enjoy program music of Beethoven, Fanny Mendelssohn, and Erik Satie, although in the case of Satie, I am flagrantly disregarding Satie's instruction to NEVER speak the text aloud.

It was built in 1823 by the Comandante of the Presidio, who was given a 10,000 acre Mexican land grant, where he raised cattle. We will gather outside the ranch house where a docent will give a lecture and tour of the grounds and probably a short tour inside, depending on the Covid-19 rules at the time. **This will be an in-person event - space is limited to the first 12 people who choose it.**
