## Hiking Boden Canyon (near Ramona)

Delightful Riparian wilderness hike! Come hike with us in one of the few remaining intact natural canyon habitats in the San Diego foothills. 





To qualify you have to have, at most, W-2 income, interest and dividends from 1099-INT and 1099-DIV, retirement income on 1099-R, claim the standard deduction, and (optionally) take the earned income tax credit (EIC). You can't have income property, a business (schedule C), capital gains (schedule D from stocks or sale of property), limited partnerships (Schedule K), energy credits or any other special situations; you can have income from your IRA or stocks held in an IRA (reported on a 1099).
