

Instructions for Using the New TV in WC Room 323

1. TV Installation

A new TV has been installed in WC Room 323. The previous TV was functional, but the HDMI connectors were damaged due to heavy cables being hung from them, which led to wear and tear. The cost to repair the old TV was higher than replacing it with a new unit. The old 60" LG TV (with its wall mount) is available for adoption. 2. TV Inputs

- **HDMI 1:** Blue Ray Player
- **HDMI 2:** VHS/DVD/DVDr
- **HDMI 3:** A cable is plugged in here and hangs about a foot below the sound bar. This cable has two strain reliefs to prevent damage from heavy cables.

3. VGA Adapter

4. Sound Bar

The sound bar is mounted at the bottom of the TV and operates with its own remote. Please ensure the sound bar's remote stays in the room (Room 323) along with the TV and other devices.

5. Adjusting the TV

The TV has a wide range of viewing angles. To adjust it, gently grip the bottom corner of the TV and move it into the desired position.

6. Internet and Streaming Services

The TV is connected to the internet and can be used to access streaming services. However, the church has not set up any streaming accounts. If you log in to your own account to stream content, you are responsible for logging out once you are finished. **Important:** If you leave the TV logged in to your account, unauthorized users could make charges to your account, and the church cannot be held responsible for these charges.
