Saturday - March 2 Arrive in San Diego

Meet your hosts and explore your neighborhood.

5:30 Gather along with your hosts for a festive Welcome Dinner prepared by our own Chef Marcus on our church campus. Get to know your fellow travelers.

Introduction to San Diego: its history, its economy, what makes it special. Enjoy a concert by our resident church musicians.

Sunday - March 3

9:30 Church Service: meet the members of our wonderful community and participate in a special reception after the service.

Visit the colorful murals of Chicano Park in Barrio Logan, recently declared a National Monument. Learn the troubled history of the park, and the triumphant success of this monument to Chicano culture.

Concert in the park: picnic in Balboa Park while listening to the sounds of the world's largest outdoor pipe organ. Visit the San Diego History Museum for a Park orientation. Spend time like a local at our International Cottages where you can enjoy dancing from around the world. Or, if you prefer be our guests at a selection of some of our favorite museums in the Park. We know your interests vary, so we will let you match the program to your tastes!

Take a brief walking tour of the Gaslamp Quarter

Travel to dinner to enjoy the vibes and flavors of the Latinx community.

Monday - March 4

9:00 Visit the World Famous San Diego Zoo. After an hour-long orientation, you'll have the entire morning to visit your favorite animals.

Lunch on your own on Coronado Island. There are a number of charming eateries in this classic beach town.

Take a walking tour of Coronado, led by a local resident and expert. Visit the famous Hotel Del Coronado, a wooden Victorian beach resort with lots of colorful history.

Return to San Diego by ferry. This short cruise provides the opportunity to see our impressive bay, shoreline, and skyline! Dinner at the church.

Tuesday - March 5

9:00 Start with a drive through the fabled enclave of La Jolla, stopping at several viewpoints. A longtime member of our community will give a tour of the University of California at San Diego (UCSD) campus, including pieces from the impressive Stuart Art Collection.

Lunch at the Cliffhanger Café at the Torrey Pines Gliderport, followed by a drive through Biotech Mesa.

Return to La Jolla, stopping to see the colony of seals and other attractions, before landing in Pacific Beach, where we will enjoy happy hour treats near the ocean. Walk down the Mission Beach boardwalk as the sun sets, followed by a bonfire and sing along.

Wednesday - March 6

Travel to Cabrillo Monument. See the famous Point Loma lighthouse and learn the history of the first European landing in San Diego. If time and tides allow, we will do some tidepooling. Visit the Naval Training Center, which has been converted into an arts and dining center. Lots of choices for lunch, as well as some interesting museums.

We know UUs like choices! We offer several options:


