Climate Action: Electric Vehicles for the Post Office

Postmaster General Louis DeJoy signed an \$11 billion contract to purchase up to 148,000 mail trucks, 90% of them powered by gasoline fueled combustion engines expected to get 8 miles per gallon. It's bad management and disastrous for the climate. But Rep. Gerry Connolly's new bill would prohibit the Postal Service from enacting its contract, unless the fleet is made up of at least 75% electric vehicles.
