#### **Climate Action: Repeal the Utility Tax NOW**

In 2022, a provision was buried in California Budget Trailer Bill 205 and passed without public notice. It requires the CPUC to add a fixed charge to electricity bills based on household income. Private utilities including SDG&E have proposed the *highest fixed charges in the country*, \$400-\$1500/year. That's 3-12 *times the national average*! This "Utility Tax" would increase energy bills for low-moderate income California apartment-dwellers who use less energy than average, and would *discourage energy conservation*. *Demand California legislators repeal this tax NOW*.
