First UU Survey Results Right Relations Team

Below are the results of our congregational survey. All survey questions used this scale: 1: Strongly Disagree 2: Disagree 3: Undecided 4: Agree 5: Strongly Agree

- **1.** I am aware of and understand our shared vision for right relations at First UU. 47% strongly agree/agree. FYI--We will revise our Vision Statement in 2024!
- Conflicts are natural in any church community.
 81% strongly agree/agree. Whew! If we know it's to be expected, then we can work with it.
- 3. I have a role to play in contributing to good relations at First UU. A whopping 84% strongly agreed/agreed. A great reflection of our UU values!
- 4. I have new skills for addressing conflict and
- 5. We currently have good relations among our congregants at First UU. The answers to both were spread almost evenly across the five options.
- 6. At First UU, we are good at addressing tough issues between congregants. 60% strongly disagreed/disagreed. Our work ahead is clear.
- 7. I know who to talk to if I have an unresolved conflict with someone at First UU. Almost half said yes and almost half said no. The revised Covenant of Right Relations (in 2024) will include a protocol for who to see and where to go if there's an ongoing conflict.

Fifty-seven responses were received; fewer than we would like, but still providing a valuable baseline.
